DESCRIPTION



An 11 storey Health Care Campus comprising social learning space with cafe and biomechanics/neurophysiology space at ground floor, podiatry suite and physiotherapy lab at first floor, paramedicine science suite and offices at second floor, optometry practice labs and tutorial rooms at third floor, clinical trial labs and student research desk space at fourth floor, nurse training facilities and academic support at fifth floor, hospital simulation space at sixth and seventh floors, office and meeting rooms at eighth and ninth floors and a garden room with viewing platform at tenth floor.

This project included major external refurbishments to include replacement cladding.
